APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Certified Copy of South African Identity Document
- Original or Certified Copy of most recent Academic Record
- Passed Grade 12 and comply with entry requirement to University
- Proof of Residency (From the Ward Councillor)
- Proof of Admission to a Tertiary Institution
- Proof of Income of Parent/Guardian

Interested / qualifying students should collect application forms from the Youth Office in Umzinto Municipal Building, any Municipal Library or from the Reception Desk in Scottburgh Municipal Offices at the corner of Bram Fischer and Williamson Streets.
